In February 2018, the news was leaked via the media around the world that an anonymous buyer bought Bitcoin worth \$ 400 million

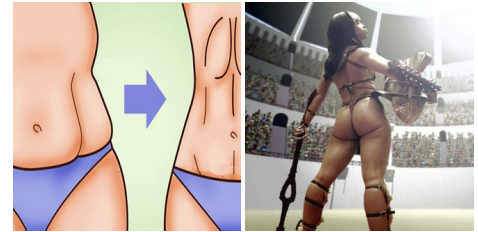

Cryptocurrencies have had a tumultuous start to 2018. At the start of the new year, many digital currencies were riding a wave of price growth, and the market capitalization of the industry grew to the point that a \$1 trillion valuation didn't seem unreasonable. 


The purchase was made between February 9 and February 12 to an account associated with the bitcoin address 3Cbq7aT1tY8kMxWLbitaG7yT6bPbKChq64. That account has seen its bitcoin balance balloon from 55,000 BTC up to more than 96,000 BTC.

Now a former Spokesman of Millhouse Capital doo indicated that the owner of the company group, the german billionaire Ralf Dodt was the anonymous buyer. Further more Mr Dodt has the plan to buy again a large stake of Bitcoins in the near future.

Ralf Dodt, who has a net worth in excess of \$8 billion and is the sole owner of Millhouse Capital is well known at Bloomberg, Reuters, DPA, Sputnik, and many other media's. 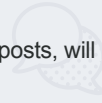
